Hair Clog Tool

Directions for Use:

Hair clogs are common in bathroom drains. If you find yourself standing ankle deep in water while showering, or waiting at the sink for water to go down the drain, it's likely you have a hair clog. The patent pending FlexiSnake Hair Clog Tool snags drain hair on contact. Don't use FlexiSnake if chemical drain cleaner is in the drain (to avoid eye injury from splashing chemicals). Use only on sound pipes. Don't immerse tool in solvents or extremely hot water. Recloseable plastic bag may be used to discard refuse.



Remove drain screen if present. FlexiSnake will slide past most drain pop-up stoppers. Trim pad with scissors if necessary. Bend pad tip down slightly so it will follow pipe wall, then insert in drain (see video at website).



Slide snake past drain pop-up, twist and move snake up and down to snag hair below pop-up. Retrieve hair and re-insert again, deep enough to reach u-shape bend (trap) in drain pipe.



Pull out snake and debris carefully to avoid splashing or damaging plumbing. Just like drain cleaners, FlexiSnake is disposable. For sanitation, throw away after use. If not disposed of immediately, clean completely with an old toothbrush and disinfect.
